
Our flagship program, which showcases organizations, projects, and individuals from across Alberta who are working to address environmental and climate change issues.

32ND ANNUAL EMERALD AWARDS



On June 7, 2023, we hosted the 32nd Annual Emerald Awards at the Citadel Theatre in Edmonton to celebrate and recognize the environmental achievements of the Emerald Award shortlist.

We were joined by numerous special guests including host Julian Faid, local indigenous hand drum group, Chubby Cree, Edmonton Mayor Amarjeet Sohi, Calgary Mayor Jyoti Gondek, Federal Environment Minister Steven Guilbeault, and Lieutenant Governor of Alberta, Her Honour, the Honourable Salma Lakhani.


